## **Brief history of Dayuan**

Dayuan was renamed Tamsui Hall during the Yongzheng period, Qing Dynasty and then changed to Tamsui Hall in Guangxu Province, and was renamed as a sub-jurisdiction of Tamsui and Hsinchu Counties in The Guangxu Period, and then in the Japanese occupation era, it was changed to Dayuanzhuang, Taoyuan County, Hsinchu Prefecture, after World War II in 1945, it was changed to Taoyuan Township in Taoyuan County, 1950, the Republic of China, it was upgraded to Dayuan Township in Taoyuan County, and on December 25, 2014, was upgraded to Dayuan, which is currently divided into 428 neighborhood neighbors and 20 villages.

## **Population growth**

The total population of the Dayuan District increased by 40,093 in 43 years, from 52,079 in 1979 to 92,172 at the end of 2021.
