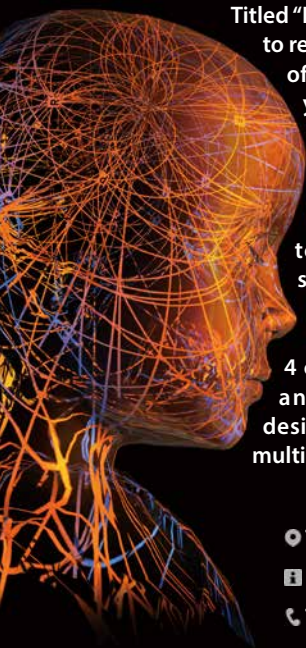

They will bring to the audience 30 works (including sound, visual recording, virtual reality, machinery, interactive installation, digital graffiti, lighting, collective art), 4 crossover performances, 7 workshops, and 3 lectures. A Garden Within The 2017 Taoyuan International Driftwood Art Festival

Eight groups of artists were invited to this festival, including Nikolay Polissky from Russia; Toshimitsu Ito from Japan; Erőss István from Hungary; Bonggi Park from South Korea; Ho Hong-Hsiung, Wang Wen-Chih, Liu Po-Chun, and Euglena Program of Art (Lu Mu-Jen and Chiao Sheng-Wei) from Taiwan.
