Artwork Collection for the 2020 Fugang Railway Installation Arts Festival



The Taiwan Railways set up the largest train headquarters in Fugang since 2018, based on the planning concept of an open public park, the core area is connected to Sanlienpo, Pogonggang Park, and Fugang Sports Park from the Fugang Train Station and along with the railway, the Taiwan Railways Fugang Train Headquarters is extended to the hinterland. The relevant reconstruction of natural and cultural landscapes, introduction of installation arts, surrounding bike lanes and connection to canals now form Fugang Railway Arts Park.

The organization of the first "2020 Fugang Railway Installation Arts Festival" (from June 5th to 14th, 2020) calls for the artwork collection and new and young artists with potential works are encourage to take a part by integrating local features and railway elements to create unique railway image. Six pieces of installation artworks are expected to be selected. Alexander Sung's 2020 Piano Recital "Professor Sung's Music Story Telling, Introduction to Beethoven in Vienna"

Professor Sung has taught and performed for 50 years. This recital especially presents the theme of "music story concert" of Beethoven's Piano Sonata. With humor and interesting tone, the recital will be conducted to allow more people to fall in love with classical music.

Stories will begin from the 25 year-old young Beethoven. At that time, Beethoven was young and ambitious and arrive in the music capital, Vienna, about two to three years. He was accomplished and having a bright future, but in 1796, he found he has the hearing problem. By 1802, his hearing was so poor that affected his performing business and teaching. In that year, he desperately wrote his younger brother the famous "Heiligenstadt Testament." What is the piece about? Everyone is welcome to the recital.




The History of Transportation Development in Daxi
