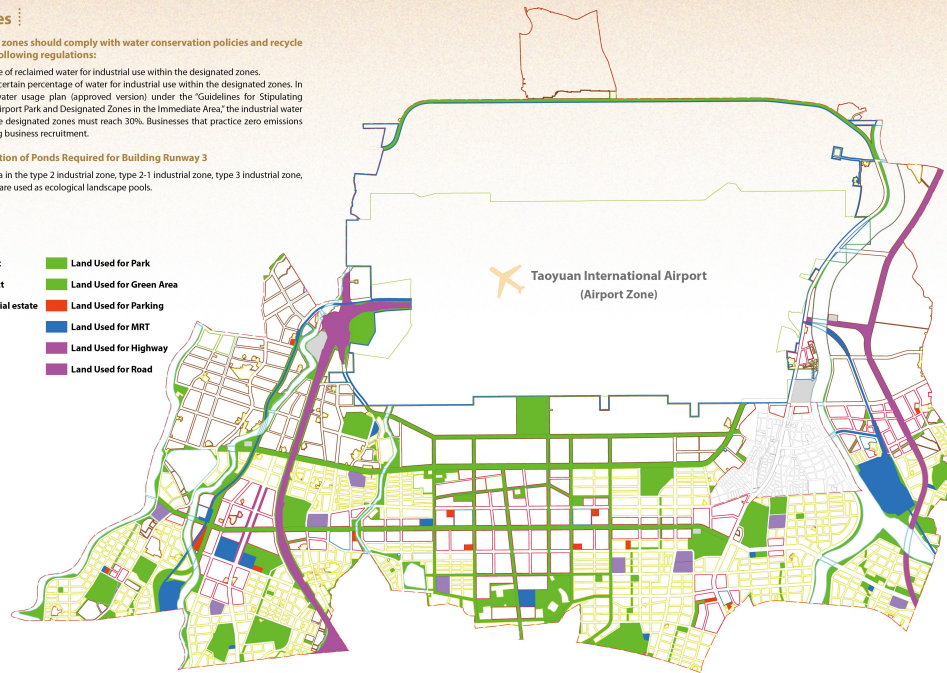
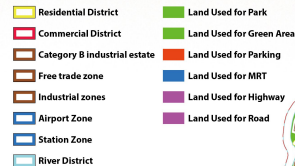
Type 3 and 4 industrial zones should comply with water conservation policies and recycle water in line with the following regulations:

1. Use a certain percentage of reclaimed water for industrial use within the designated zones.
2. Recycle and circulate a certain percentage of water for industrial use within the designated zones. In accordance with the water usage plan (approved version) under the "Guidelines for Stipulating Taoyuan International Airport Park and Designated Zones in the Immediate Area," the industrial water recycling rate within the designated zones must reach 30%. Businesses that practice zero emissions will be prioritized during business recruitment.

Remedy for the Relocation of Ponds Required for Building Runway 3

At least 5% of the land area in the type 2 industrial zone, type 2-1 industrial zone, type 3 industrial zone, and type 4 industrial zone are used as ecological landscape pools.

The Heart of Asia | The Gateway to Taiwan

Project Origin

Recently, in response to the growth of air transport in the Asia Pacific, for both passengers and cargo, Taoyuan International Airport plans to build a third terminal and third runway, thereby expanding its capacity and elevating Taiwan's national competitiveness. The Taoyuan City Government is also promoting the Taoyuan Aerotropolis project, a national-level flagship project that leverages Taoyuan International Airport as an engine of growth.

Taoyuan International Airport's spillover effect is expected to attract relevant industries to cluster, propelling the economy around the airport and forming an airport-centric metropolis that is diverse and functional. Ultimately, the project will promote economic growth in Taoyuan city and generate industry transformation in Taiwan.

Scope and Area

The project covers an area of 4,564.32 hectares, of which 1,733 hectares are for airport zone, 109 hectares serve as a free trade zone, 563 hectares are dedicated industrial zones, 322 hectares are commercial districts, and 558 hectares are residential districts. Also, 977 hectares are reserved for public facilities such as parks, roads, and plazas.

Development Scope of Taoyuan Aerotropolis

An area of **286.95** hectares is used for Phase I industrial zone development
